

French Culture & the Mediterranean

May 10-27 2021 June 25 - July 12, 2021

Program description

- This interdisciplinary class explores the culture, history, and language of southern
 France from the gorgeous town of Aix-en-Provence. Students participate in class
 excursions and readings, then design individual projects based in their field of interest
 (for example, history, French language, art, religion, or communications). The trip
 includes (but is not limited to):
 - Site visits, including Cezanne's studio
 - Cultural activities (may include a wine tasting, cooking class, or art lesson)
 - Walking tours around historic Aix-en-Provence
 - Day excursions to Marseille and the Provence region
 - 3 days in Paris!
- Study Abroad is carefully monitoring the conditions domestically and in the destination country. If travel is cancelled due to COVID-19 health & safety issues, participants will be issued refunds.
 - If the trip has to be cancelled, students who need the course credit will have virtual options.

Who can go?

 Current Averett students (undergraduate & graduate). Interested Averett alumni/staff should contact Dr. Clark.

 - Choose French Culture & the Mediterranean, then "Apply." You will be prompted to create a secure account.

 Program cost: \$4,800 (includes international airfare, ground transportation, lodging, guides and entrance fees, some meals, excursion costs, insurance).
